


You will need:

- Construction paper
- Popsicle stick or jumbo craft stick
- Glue
- Scissors
- Markers
- Ruler



Directions:

1. Measure and cut the following strips out of whatever color construction paper you want: 12" x 1 1/4", 6" x 3/4", 3 1/2" x 1/2" and 4 1/2" x 1/4". Accordion fold each strip.
2. Glue one end of the 3/4" wide strip to one end of the largest strip, then glue one end of the 1/2" wide strip to the free end of the 3/4" strip and then glue one end of the 1/4" strip to the free end of the 1/2" strip.
3. Cut a popsicle stick or jumbo craft stick in half and tape the cut ends together.
4. Cut out 2, 3" x 1 1/4" rectangles out of the construction paper and round off one end of the rectangles.
5. Glue each piece to the top and bottom of the sticks.





6. Trace about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the head onto white paper and then add another $\frac{1}{4}$ " around that line. Repeat and cut out so you have 2 sets of teeth.





7. Cut small triangles out around the outside of each white piece of paper and fold up the teeth.



Step 7

8. Glue teeth inside the mouth of the alligator.



Step 8

9. Cut a 6" x $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of red paper, accordion fold about half of one end and round off the other end.



Step 9

10. Glue this inside the mouth to give the alligator his chomping ability!



Step 10

11. Make 3-D eyes and nose by cutting out four U shapes and bending part of the flat end back. Draw on eyes and nostrils and glue onto the head.



Step 11

Optional: use wiggly eyes instead of drawing them on.

12. Glue the head to the widest end of the body.



Step 12

13. Cut out 4 legs and glue onto the widest part of the body.



14. Make several for your very own congregation of alligators!
