

You will need:

- Construction paper
- Straw
- Glue and/or tape
- Scissors
- Marker




Optional:

- Wiggly eyes



Directions:

1. Print out the provided template or draw out onto paper and cut out.
2. Fold a full sheet of construction paper in half and fold in half again. Place the head piece of the template on the folded edge and trace.
3. Cut out the head. Unfold, now you have 2 identical heads!
4. Trace the trunk and tusks onto construction paper and cut out.
5. Glue or tape a straw onto the middle of one of the heads (see image).



6. Glue or tape the trunk over the straw.



7. Glue the 2nd head over top of the trunk and straw.



8. Glue on tusks and eyes and decorate however you would like.

Note: Make sure to decorate the side with the trunk on top of the straw.



9. Wrap the end of the trunk around a marker or pencil and roll up to the top and remove the marker/pencil. Blow through the straw and make the trunk move!!!
