


Cougar Mask

You will need:

- White cardstock
- Printer
- Scissors
- Popsicle or jumbo stick
- Glue

Optional:

- Hole punch
- Yarn or string
- Markers or crayons



Directions:

- 1. Print out either the colored or the blank cougar mask.
- 2. Cut out the mask along the dotted line in the colored mask or the solid line of the blank mask.
- 3. Cut out the black circles in the eyes to make the eyeholes.
- 4. If you opted for the blank mask, color your mask.
- 5. Glue a popsicle or jumbo stick onto the lower back of your mask.
- 6. Or using a hole punch, make a hole on each side of the mask (see below) and tie a piece of string or yarn to each hole for hands free cougaring!
